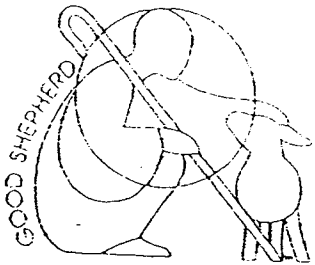

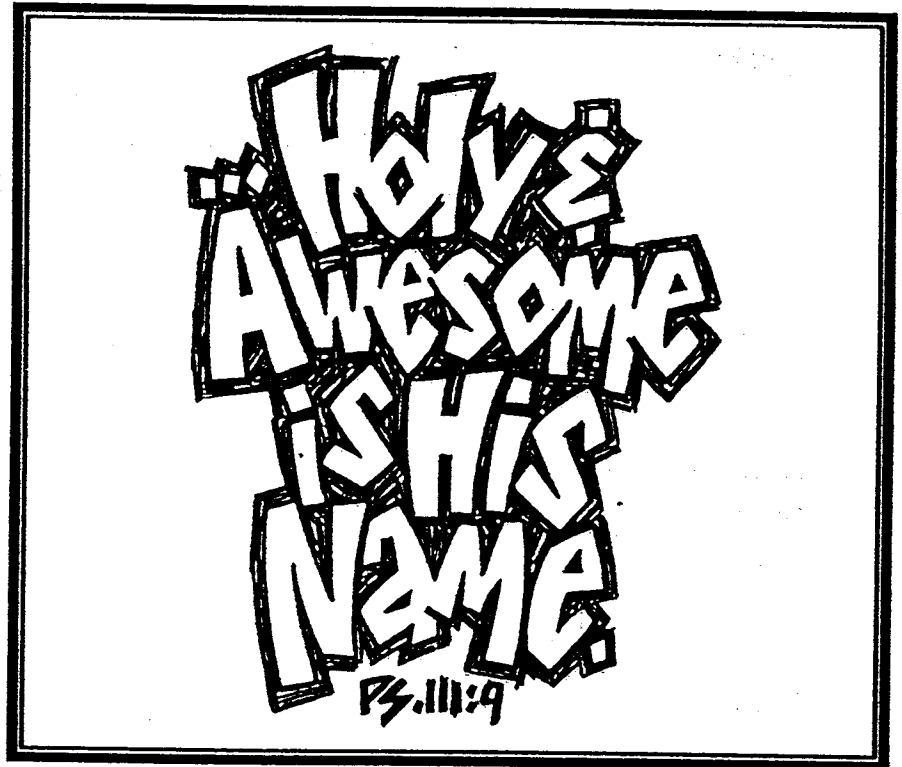

**WELCOME!**





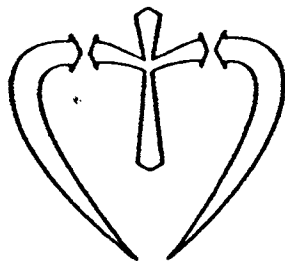

**The third day he rose again from the dead.**


