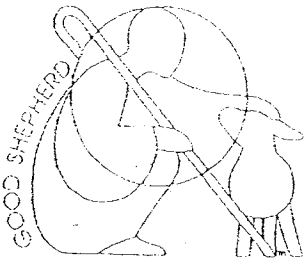

A GUIDELINE FROM GOD

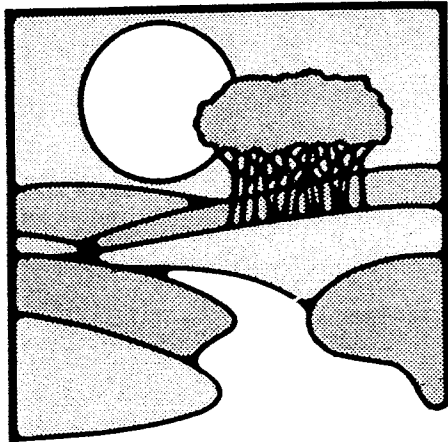




Leader: We worship as we live: in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

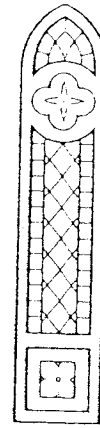

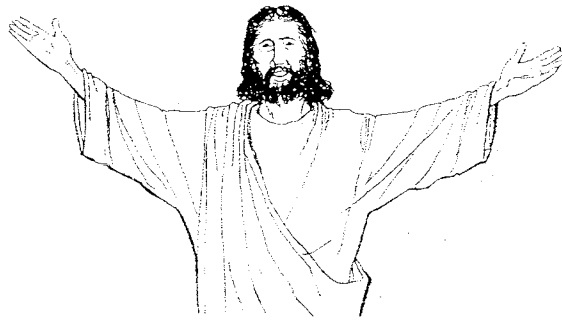
The Celebration of the Lord's Supper


