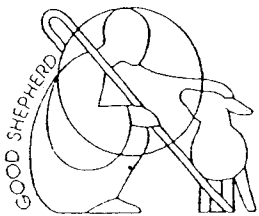

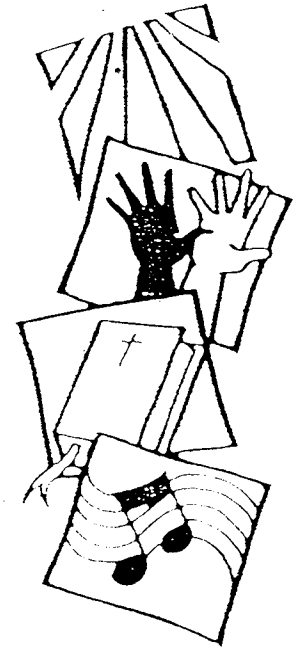
*Dress Casually* (If you wish)

### **Welcome to Good Shepherd**

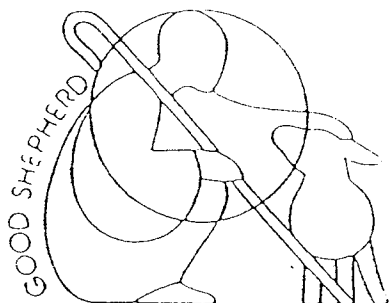
