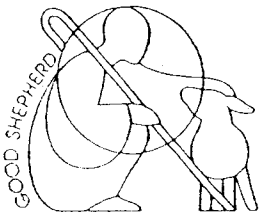


Welcome to all of you

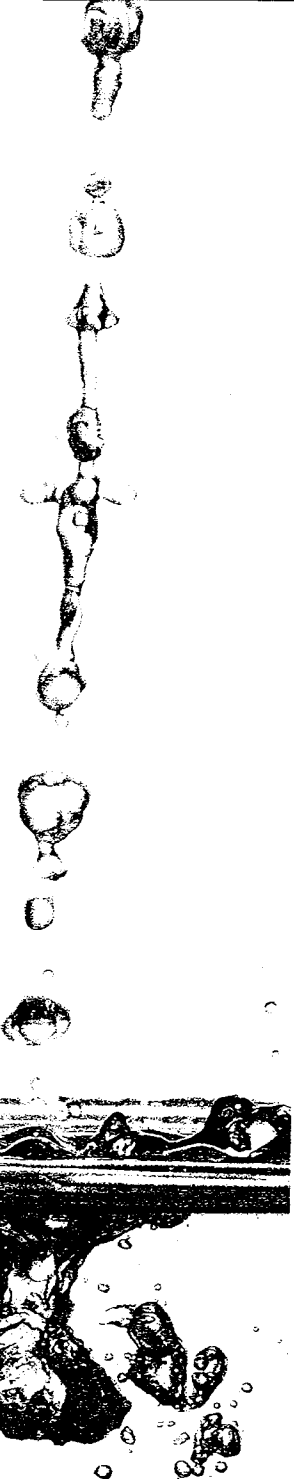

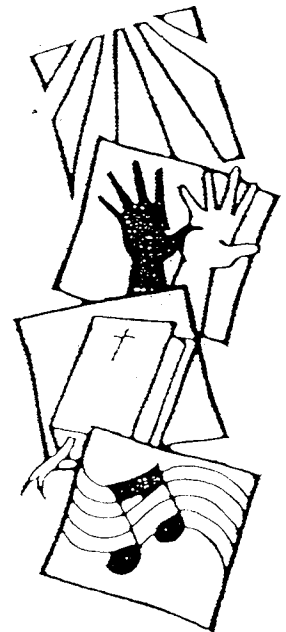
*Dress Casually* (If you wish)
