THE ABSOLUTION

WE CONFESS THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

L: We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord. When the generations to come ask: what does this mean, what do you say?

And take Your ransomed servants home.

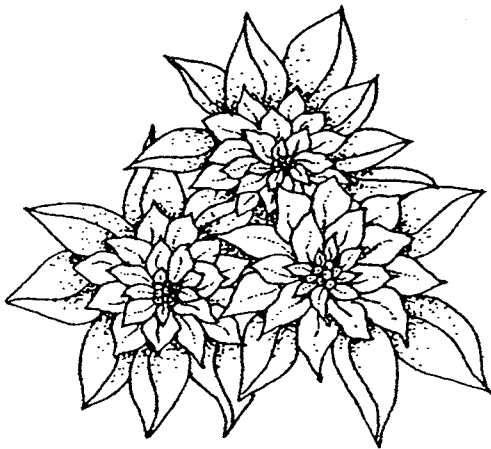

WELCOME TO GOOD SHEPHERD

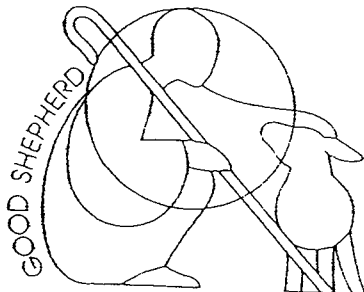
