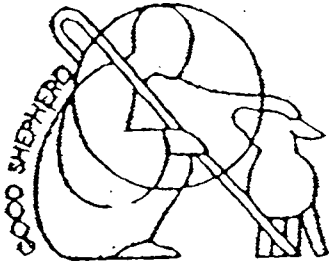

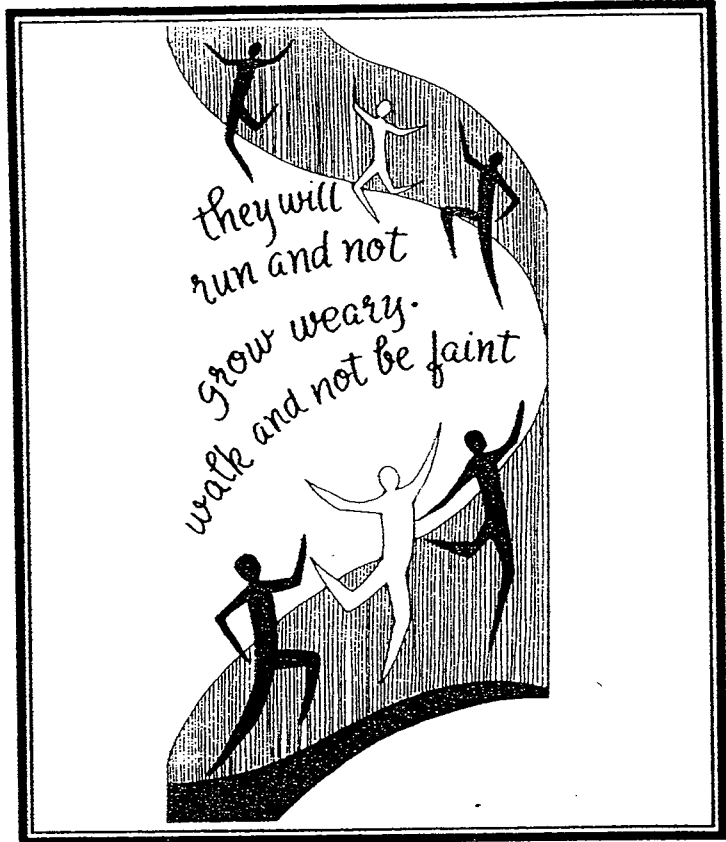



WELCOME TO GOOD SHEPHERD

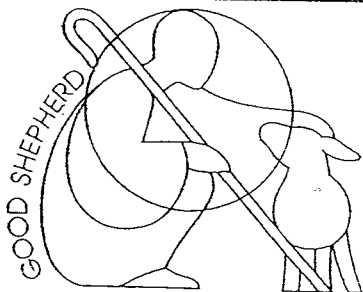
