For all this I deserve Your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior, Jesus Christ, I pray:
Lord, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Leader: God, our heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given us His only Son to be the atoning Sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,


the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints,

to glorify you. Amen*

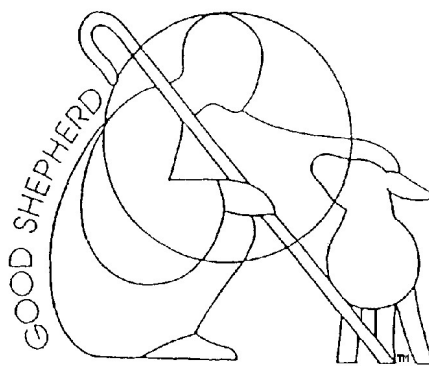
