As CDC guidelines have been adjusted in recent days, we want to keep you informed about our upcoming church building relaxed guidelines.

Some changes have been made in recent weeks. Examples include: 1) monthly greeters (there are 3 months open for volunteers); 2) blue tape has been removed from the pews; 3) offering plate has been placed on the altar. As we show love yet remain sensitive, here are some additional ways we are transitioning to pre-covid activities.

Beginning Thursday, June 3rd and Sunday, June 6th

- side/East door will be open for worshipers to enter.
- guest book/lectern will be at the main entrance.
- coat racks and narthex restrooms will be available for use.
- volunteers may be serving coffee and/or treats in the narthex/fellowship hall.
- worship folders and an offering basket will be on the narthex table (right of the double doors).
- Communion will be served at the railings (in groups of 10 on each side)
** Please note that those who are sensitive to this may request to receive individualized communion from a pastor after the worship service.*
- Wafers in plastic bags are available in back of church.
- Ushers will continue to dismiss worshipers from the front.

Beginning Thursday, July 1st and Sunday, July 4th
after evaluation of June's practices

- Ushers will hand out worship folders (also available on the narthex table).
- Communion registration sheets will be on the narthex table.
- Ushers will pass offering baskets down the pews.
- Communion will be served at the railings (in groups of 10 on each side) for everyone.
- Communion assistants will distribute the wafers.
