From the pen of a dusty theologian

"A sheep must live entirely by its shepherd's help, protection, and care. As soon as it loses him, it is surrounded by all kinds of dangers and must perish.

The reason? It is quite unable to help itself. It is a poor, weak, sim-

ple little beast that can neither feed nor rule itself, nor find the right way, nor protect itself against any kind of danger or misfortune.

Moreover, a sheep is by nature shy, timid and likely to go astray. When a sheep does

go a bit astray, it

leaves its shepherd. It is unable to find its way back to him; indeed, a straying sheep merely runs ever farther away from its shepherd.

Though a sheep may find other shepherds and sheep, that does not help it, for it does not know the voices of strange shepherds. Therefore the sheep flees from them also, going ever further. It strays until the wolf seizes it, or until it perishes alone some other way. . . .


This Good Shepherd, however, Whom the prophet foretold so long before, is Christ our dear Lord. Jesus is a shepherd much different from Moses.

Moses is harsh and unfriendly toward his sheep. Moses lays down rules, drives sheep away into the desert to wander, starve, die.

Christ, however, is the good, friendly Shepherd. He goes after a famished and lost sheep in the wilder-

ness, seeks it there and, when he has found it, lays it on his shoulder rejoicing.

Jesus Christ even "gave His life for His sheep." He is a friendly Shepherd. Who would not be happy to be His sheep?

Heavenly Father, You gathered us to bless us once again. And once again You lead each of us to confess our sins to You and to each other.


Merciful Father in heaven, I am completely sinful from birth. I have sinned against You. I do not deserve to be called Your child. Your Word



BIBLE READING DURING JESUS' LIFE—John 10:11-18 (EHV)

11 "I AM the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep. 12 The hired man, who is not a shepherd, does not own the

sheep. He sees the wolf coming, leaves the sheep, and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the sheep and scatters them.

13 Because he works for money, he does not care about the sheep.

14 "I AM the Good Shepherd. I know My sheep and My sheep know Me 15 (just as the Father knows Me and I know the Father). And I lay down My life for the sheep. ¹⁶I also have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also, and they will listen to My voice.

Then there will be one flock and one Shepherd. 17 This is why the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it up again. 18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down on My own. I have the au-

thority to lay it down, and I have the authority to take it up again. This is the commission I received from My Father."

⁸ Look after yourselves and everyone the Holy Spirit has placed in your care. Be like shepherds to God's church. It is the flock He bought with the blood of His own Son.

²⁹ I know that after I am gone, others will come like fierce wolves to attack you. ³⁰ Some of your own people will tell lies to win over the Lord's followers. ³¹ Be on your guard! Remember how day and night for three years I kept warning you with tears in my eyes.

32 I now place you in God's care. Remember the message about His gift of undeserved grace! This message can help you and give you what belongs to you as God's people.

BIBLE LETTER AFTER JESUS' ASCENSION -1 John 4:1-6 (MSG)

My dear friends, don't believe everything you hear. Carefully weigh and examine what people tell you. Not everyone who talks about God comes from God. There are a lot of lying preachers loose in the world.

²⁻³ Here's how you test for the genuine Spirit of God. Everyone who confesses openly his faith in Jesus Christ—the

Son of God, who came as an actual flesh-and-blood person—comes from God and belongs to God.

And everyone who refuses to confess faith in Jesus has nothing in common with God. This is the spirit of antichrist that you heard was coming. Well, here it is, sooner than we thought!


Listen to exciting echoes of God's great good news in the days or years the Lord has planned for us. What comfort! What joy!


