

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me.


Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.





Alberta M. "Bertie" Schroeder, age 94, of Wisconsin Rapids, WI answered Jesus's call on Monday, April 22, 2024 in Wisconsin Rapids, Wi, Bertie was born on August 15, 1929 in Wisconsin Rapids to the late William and Mamie (Gottschalk) Schroeder, She went to St. Paul's Lutheran School before graduating from Lincoln High School in 1947. Professionally, Bertie dedicated 40 years to Consolidated Papers Inc. as a bookkeeper and Special Payroll Supervisor, Bertie was always dedicated to her faith. She was a member of the St. Paul's Ev. Lutheran Church, Willing Workers, and sang in the church choir for many years. Bertie also sang many solos at weddings and funerals throughout the years. In 1988 Bertie became a charter member of Good Shepherd Lutheran where she joined the Ladies Group and was the organist for 20 years. Bertie was a member of the "Any Day" club with her close friends. Along with her sister, Marge, she loved to travel; sharing many trips with friends and family including Bertie's annual bowling tournaments. She loved playing games and cards and enjoyed many parlor games with her friends at River Run. She was a regular winner at BINGO! Bertie loved crafts and sewing. She embroidered hundreds of dishtowels for family and friends. Bertie and her sister also blessed Good Shepherd with beautiful handmade banners and paraments. Bertie is fondly remembered for making Christmas special with carol singing, ice cream drinks, and beautifully wrapped presents, as well as homemade ornaments for all the great-nieces and nephews. Having a close family was important to Bertle. She and her sister Marge always lived in the family home taking care of their father and mother. Bertle and Marge moved into a duplex in 2000. Some years following Marge's passing Bertie moved into River Run in 2015. Not having children of her own, Bertie's brothers' children were blessings to her, as she was to them.
