

Bible discussions on the *Gospel of Mark* chapters 14-15

1. Mark 14:12-16 Prepping for the Passover, we see how Jesus revealed His fore-knowledge and attention to detail. How does He reveal His compassion for His disciples?

2. How did Jesus use His Old Testament Passover Festival to set the stage for the next few days?

3. Mark 15:1-15 Jesus is a convicted state criminal. What's your take-away about the political AND social pressures of Jesus' day?

4. What thoughts does the Holy Spirit bring to your mind with His Word's record of the injustices brought against the One whom God sent to bless them?

For next week, let's think about God's Words recorded in Mark 16. Some thoughts while reading the last 20 verses of God's gospel of Mark for next week might include: All Jerusalem had just celebrated the Feast of the Passover, in three more days they all get to celebrate the Feast of Firstfruits.

Jesus' loud cry entering death at 3:00pm,

an earthquake at 3:00pm,

the ripping of the temple curtain at 3:00pm,

ripped from the top downwards,

the centurion's shock and awe, Jesus' corpse pierced,

Jesus corpse placed into rock-tomb with rock door
