
Welcome to Good Shepherd Ev. Lutheran Church and School!

So, we thank God and we thank you, for your presence today. If you are visiting Good Shepherd, either in person or online, and are moved to give a gift to our ministries, thank you.



The sign-up sheet is located in the narthex. Please invite a friend! There is also an opportunity to donate necessary food items.








2025-2026 SCHOOL REGISTRATION
